C stands for consonant

V stands for vowel

CVVC = First vowel is long, second vowel is silent
VCV = First vowel is long, second vowel is silent
VCCCV = First vowel is short, second vowel is silent
CVCV = First vowel is long, second vowel is silent
CVC = Vowel is short
CV = Vowel is long
